We define green electricity as a subset of renewable electricity that is derived from natural processes and renewable resources that provide the greatest environmental benefit and a zero- or near-zero emission profile (incl. the avoidance of biogenic emissions).

- Exclusively using green electricity for our operations, and working with our suppliers and partners to encourage the use of green electricity in their operations
- Monitoring and reporting on our energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions to track our progress towards our sustainability goals, and specifically reporting on our use of green electricity
- Resorting to green electricity products that promote additionality whenever possible
- Investing in green electricity projects and technologies that provide the greatest environmental benefit and a zero, or near-zero, emission profile, such as solar photovoltaic and wind power
- Educating our employees and stakeholders on the benefits of green electricity, and encouraging them to adopt sustainable practices
- Regularly reviewing and updating this Policy to ensure that it remains aligned with our sustainability goals and the latest industry standards

4. RESPONSIBILITY

The Management Board of the Nordex Group is responsible for ensuring adherence to the commitment of procuring 100% green electricity and local plant management in collaboration with Corporate Real Estate Management and the applicable Sourcing Board. Global Sustainability has responsibility for overseeing the implementation.

By implementing this policy, we aim to continuously improve our climate impact and contribute to a more sustainable future. We believe that the use of green electricity is a critical component of our overall sustainability strategy, and we are committed to promoting its use throughout our operations and supply chain.
