### Life Saving Rules


























Safety is a core value in Nordex Group.

### Stop Work Authority

# We have the responsibility to say stop


If we see an act or situation which looks unsafe, then we have the responsibility to stop work until we are satisfied that work can restart safely.



### Lifting Operations

### We follow the lifting plan

We do not perform any lifting operations without being trained and authorized. We respect the restricted zone under lifting activities and control access to this area. We check that loads are correctly secured and never leave a suspended load unattended. We do not stand or walk under suspended loads.



### Working at Height

## We protect ourselves when working at height

We only work at height when there are fall protection measures in place or we use fall protection equipment. We never work at two levels in parallel. We secure tools and materials to prevent dropped objects.



### Personal Protective Equipment

### We wear the required PPE

We always use the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment for each task and check it before starting work.





### **Confined Spaces**

## We have a valid permit before entering a confined space

We always use a Confined space Permit process before entering a Confined space and ensure all specified controls are in place and followed throughout the work.



### Safe Driving

### We follow the safety rules when we drive

We drive safely and considerately. We make sure we are fit to drive before setting off. We always wear seat belts and do not exceed speed limits. We avoid distraction and never hold a phone while driving.



Lock out Tag out (LOTO)

## We follow the Lock out Tag out (LOTO) procedure

We always use the LOTO procedure to protect against stored energy (electrical, mechanical, hydraulic). We never override a safety interlock.

We use high energy tools according to instructions.

### We never work alone


We always work together with colleagues so we can assist each other if needed.

## We do not put ourselves or others in danger


We do not instigate, participate in or allow unsafe acts that could cause serious injury or death. We take care of each other.
